This Office represents the Board of Regents of the University of the State of New York; its Chancellor, Merryl Tisch; David Steiner, Commissioner of New York State Education Department¹; and Elsa Magee, Acting President of the New York State Higher Education Services Corporation, collectively the State Defendants.
